123 kid's bible questions

The Kids' Questions are to help you teach your children and discover how much they're remembering. These questions range from simple to more complicated and you can choose which ones best fit your children. Feel free to add your own questions, too. As you ask your questions the children will likely have questions of their own so take the time to discuss them, too.

Questions about God

Q: How many Gods are there?

A: One.

Q: What is the Trinity?

A: God the Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

Q: Give four names for God.

A: Christ, Jesus, Lord, Father, King, etc.

Q: Who made God?

A: No one, God is eternal – no beginning and no end.

Q: Where is God?

A: In heaven and everywhere.

Q: Is there anyone or anything more powerful than God?

A: No.

Q: Name three miracles God has done.

A: Created the world, parted the Red Sea, came to earth as a human, walked on water, etc.

Q: What does God know?

A: Everything.

Questions about the Bible

Q: Who wrote the Bible?

A: God told His people exactly what to write.

Q: Does the Bible have any mistakes?

A: No, it is perfect.

Q: What is the most important thing in the Bible?

A: Jesus.

Q: What part of the Bible is about the time before Jesus was born?

A: Old Testament.

Q: What part of the Bible is about the time after Jesus was born?

A: New Testament.

Q: How many books are in the Bible?

A: 66.

Q: How many books in the Old Testament?

A: 39.

Q: How many books in the New Testament?

A: 27.

Q: What is the first book of the Bible?

A: Genesis.

Q: What is the last book of the Bible?

A: Revelation.

Q: Name three people who wrote books of the Bible.

A: Moses, David, Solomon, Paul, John, etc.

Q: What are the four Gospels?

A: Matthew, Mark, Luke, John.

Q: What is in the four Gospels?

A: The story of Jesus' life?

Q: What is a prophet?

A: A spokesman for God.

Q: Name three prophets.

A: Moses, Isaiah, Jeremiah, etc.

Q: What book of the Bible was written especially for the young?

A: Proverbs (see chapter 1:4)

Questions about Jesus

Q: Who is Jesus?

A: God.

Q: Where was Jesus born?

A: Bethlehem.

Q: Who was Jesus' earthly dad?

A: Joseph.

Q: Who was Jesus' mom?

A: Mary.

Q: Did Jesus ever sin?

A: No.

Q: Who were Jesus' brothers?

A: James and Jude.

Q: Who were some of Jesus' friends?

A: Peter, James, John, Mary, Martha, Lazarus, etc.

Q: How did Jesus die?

A: People nailed him to a cross.

Q: What did they stick into his heart when Jesus died?

A: A spear.

Q: What did they do with Jesus' body?

A: Wrapped it up and put it in a grave.

Q: How long was Jesus dead?

A: Three days.

Q: Is Jesus dead today?

A: No, He rose from the dead.

Q: Where is Jesus today?

A: In heaven and with us.

Q: What do we celebrate at Christmas?

A: Jesus birth.

Q: What do we celebrate at Easter?

A: Jesus resurrection.

Q: Is Jesus coming back to earth?

A: Yes, to take us to heaven.

Q: Why did Jesus die?

A: To pay the penalty of our sins.

Q: Why did Jesus die for our sins?

A: Because he loves us.

Questions about the Disciples

Q: What is a disciple?

A: Someone who follows and learns from a teacher.

Q: Name three of Jesus' disciples.

A: Peter, Andrew, James, John, Philip, Bartholomew, Thomas, James, Thaddeus, Simon, Judas

Q: Who was the man who hated Christians before God changed him and made him a Christian?

A: Saul, whose name was changed to Paul.

Q: Which disciple betrayed Jesus?

A: Judas.

Q: Who was one of Jesus' best friends and the youngest disciple?

A: John.

Q: Who was the head disciple?

A: Peter.

Q: Which disciple doubted that Jesus rose from the dead?

A: Thomas.

Questions about Creation

Q: How did God make everything?

A: By speaking.

Q: Why did God make everything?

A: For us to enjoy.

Q: Why did God make everything so beautiful?

A: Because God is an artist.

Questions about Christian Life

Q: What is a Christian?

A: Someone who believes in Jesus.

Q: What is prayer?

A: When we talk to God.

Q: What can we pray to God about?

A: Everything.

Q: Why do we want to obey God?

A: Because He loves us and it's good for us.

Q: Whom are we supposed to worship?

A: God alone.

Q: Should we worship other people?

A: No.

Q: What are some ways we worship God?

A: Reading the Bible, praying, singing to Him, telling others about Him, obeying Him, obeying mom and dad, etc.

Q: Give three reasons Christians go to church?

A: To learn about God, to receive the Lord's supper, to remember what He's done for us, to see Christian friends, etc.

Q: What is communion?

A: It is Jesus' body and blood together with bread and wine.

Q: Why do people receive the Lord's supper?

A: To remember His death and to receive forgiveness.

Q: What is baptism?

A: One way God puts faith in our hearts.

Q: Why do people give money at church?

A: To show love for God and to help proclaim His word.

Q: What should Christians do to people who aren't Christians?

A: Be nice to them, tell them about Jesus, pray for them, etc.

Q: Name a child in the Bible.

A: David, Samuel, Jesus, Joseph, etc.

Q: Who hit his brother and killed him?

A: Cain killed Abel.

Questions about Heaven

Q: Can you get to heaven by being good?

A: No.

Q: How do you get to heaven?

A: By believing in Jesus.

Q: Do all people go to heaven when they die?

A: No, only those who believe in Jesus.

Q: What will we do in heaven?

A: Sing, eat, play, be with God, many things that bring joy.

Q: Will there be kids in heaven?

A: Yes, God works faith in children too.

Q: Will animals be in heaven?

A: If you need them to be happy.

Q: Will heaven be scary?

A: No, everything will be fun and it never gets dark.

Q: Who is in charge of heaven?

A: God.

Q: Will there be angels in heaven?

A: Yes, and they will sing to God with us.

Q: Will anyone sin in heaven?

A: No.

Q: Will anyone ever get sick or die in heaven?

A: No.

Q: Will anyone be sad in heaven?

A: No.

Q: Will there be music in heaven?

A: Yes, God loves music. Angels, people, instruments will all sing and make music in heaven.

Q: Will there be parties in heaven?

A: Yes.

Q: What might we do at those parties?

A: Eat food, sing, dance, laugh, play, see people, see God, etc.

Questions about Sin

Q: What is sin?

A: Sin is something we are born with and what we do when we disobey God.

Q: What are some sins?

A: Not sharing, lying, being greedy, etc.

Q: Is it a sin to not do what your mom or dad say?

A: Yes.

Q: What sin did the Israelites do while wandering in the desert.

A: Whined and complained.

Q: Is it a sin to make a mistake?

A: No, everyone makes mistakes like spilling milk, that's not a sin.

Q: Who sins?

A: Everyone except Jesus.

Q: Why did Jesus die?

A: For our sins.

Q: What should we do when we sin?

A: Be sorry for it, trust that God forgives me because of Jesus and ask His help to not sin.

Q: What should we do when we sin against someone?

A: Tell him or her we're sorry and ask for forgiveness.

Q: What should we do when someone sins against us?

A: Forgive them as Jesus has forgiven us.

Questions about the gospel

Q: What is the gospel?

A: It is the good news that Jesus has taken away our sins and it is the power to save us.

Q: What is repentance?

A: It is being sorry for sin and trusting that God forgives us.

Q: What is grace?

A: God's undeserved love for people who sin.

Q: What is mercy?

A: Another word for grace.

Q: What is faith?

A: Trusting in Jesus.

Questions for boys

Q: Name four godly men in the Bible.

A: Moses, Joseph, Aaron, Caleb, John, etc.

Q: Name two warriors in the Bible.

A: David, Samson, Gideon.

Q: Name the strongest man in the Bible.

A: Samson.

Q: Name two godly kings in the Bible.

A: David, Josiah, Jesus, etc.

Q: Name a sinful king in the Bible.

A: Pharaoh, Herod, etc.

Q: Name two people in the Bible who used a sword.

A: David, Gideon, Peter.

Q: Who is the shepherd boy who killed Goliath?

A: David.

Q: What weapon did David use to kill Goliath?

A: A sling with a rock in it.

Q: Name three things God wants a Christian husband to do.

A: Love God, love his wife, work hard.

Q: Name three things that a Christian daddy is supposed to do.

A: Love God, love his children, teach his children about Jesus, take his children to church, pray with his kids, play with his kids, discipline his children, etc.

Q: What did John the Baptist wear?

A: Camels hair coat.

Q: What will Jesus do to Satan when He returns?

A: Send him to hell.

Questions for girls

Q: Name three godly women in the Bible.

A: Mary, Ruth, Esther, Miriam, etc.

Q: Name two sinful women from the Bible.

A: Delilah, Potiphar's wife, Jezebel, etc.

Q: Who is Jesus' mom?

A: Mary.

Q: Which lady sang and danced to worship God after he parted the Red Sea?

A: Moses sister, Miriam.

Q: Name three things God wants a Christian wife to do.

A: Love God, respect her husband, work hard, take care of her family, etc.

Q: Name three things a Christian mom should do.

A: Love God, love her kids, teach her children about Jesus, read the Bible to her children, pray with them,

play with them, sing with them, etc.

Q: Who should tell a girl who she should marry?

A: Her daddy.

Q: Name a princess or a queen in the Bible.

A: Esther, Pharaoh's daughter.

Silly questions

Q: Who is the short man in the Bible who climbed a tree to see Jesus?

A: Zacchaeus.

Q: What did the children sing when Jesus came into town?

A: Hosanna.

Q: What swallowed Jonah?

A: A big fish.

Q: What did John the Baptist eat?

A: Bugs and honey.

Q: What animal brought food to Elijah the prophet?

A: A raven.
