REACT

TODAY: "...he gave his <u>one and only Son</u>..."

Scripture focus: John 14:1-14

Lesson Objective: To discover God's reliability and live each day aware of his presence in our daily life.

REWIND

Read John 14:1-14.

The Context: Jesus is talking with his disciples the night before his death and had just finished predicting Peter's denial of him (13:38). Jesus started talking about going someplace they could not go. For almost three years they had gone everywhere with Jesus. They had given up their livelihoods to follow Jesus. Now it appeared that relationship was coming to an end. What changes were coming? Would the disciples have to fend for themselves when Jesus was gone? In vv.16-17 Jesus promises them the gift of the Holy Spirit--a promise that they surely didn't fully comprehend yet. And what were they expecting all along? Maybe they followed Jesus at least partly under the belief that his was an earthly kingdom of glory, not an invisible kingdom of grace--a common misunderstanding back Jesus day. With such a wrong understanding of the nature of Christ's kingdom, we still struggle, too.

REFLECT

(v.1) - Why were the disciples troubled?

Jesus said there was no other way to the Father except through him.

The Greek word for "one and only" is a compound word-*monos* = "only"--and--*genes* = "unique, family, offspring. In the Bible lots of times it refers to one's children (So-and-so "begat" so-and-so). You see the same word earlier at the beginning of John's Gospel. The same idea is present in Psalm 2:7 (*See below*).

- → Psalm 2:7 He said to me, "You are my son; today I have become your father."
- → John 1:18 No one has ever seen God, but the one and only Son, who is himself God and is in closest relationship with the Father, has made him known.
- → John 1:14 The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the one and only Son, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth.
- (v.9) What was at the heart of Jesus' question to Philip?
- (vv.13,14) What does Jesus promise to do for us? What is the key to making requests of Jesus?




