MISSION HISTORY IN VIETNAM, A Timeline...

Training Invitation - Zang Lou from the Hmong Fellowship Church (HFC) come across an online sermon by Rev. Bounkeo Lor, a Hmong pastor at Grace Hmong Lutheran Church in Kansas City, Kansas. Encouraged by Lor's message and deeply impressed with the clear proclamation of law and gospel, Lou invites Lor to train 60 leaders of the Hmong Fellowship Church (HFC) in Hanoi, Vietnam. **The HFC has 55,000 church members.**

First trip to Vietnam - Lor makes the first of his training trips to Hanoi.

Letter to WELS - The HFC leaders draft a letter to WELS leadership asking for additional training

Support begins - WELS Missions begins full financial support of the Hmong outreach effort in Vietnam

PSI visits Vietnam - The Pastoral Studies Institute (PSI) visits Vietnam for the first time to aid in Lor's training efforts. **The HFC grows to 70,000 members.**

Divine call - Lor is called to be full-time Hmong Asia ministry coordinator.

Visit to the United States - Leaders from the Hmong Fellowship Church and Vietnamese Fellowship Church travel to the United States to learn about WELS operations. WELS welcomes them to the Center for Mission and Ministry in Waukesha, WI, and Wisconsin Lutheran Seminary in Mequon, WI. (Continues next page)

THE SERMON, Based on Colossians 1:3-8

Theme: "God's Grace Is Growing!"

<u>**Colossians 1:3-8</u>**: We always thank God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, when we pray for you, ⁴ because we have heard of your faith in Christ Jesus and of the love you have for all God's people—⁵ the faith and love that spring from the hope stored up for you in heaven and about which you have already heard in the true message of the gospel ⁶ that has come to you. FIRST LESSON: ISAIAH 6:1-8 (The LORD who commissions Isaiah to prophetic office, is the same LORD who would one day atone for his sins on the altar of the cross). In the year that King Uzziah died, I saw the Lord, high and exalted, seated on a throne; and the train of his robe filled the temple.² Above him were seraphim, each with six wings: With two wings they covered their faces, with two they covered their feet, and with two they were flying. ³And they were calling to one another: "Holy, holy, holy is the LORD Almighty; the whole earth is full of his glory." ⁴At the sound of their voices the doorposts and thresholds shook and the temple was filled with smoke. ⁵ "Woe to me!" I cried. "I am ruined! For I am a man of unclean lips, and I live among a people of unclean lips, and my eyes have seen the King, the LORD Almighty." ⁶Then one of the seraphim flew to me with a live coal in his hand, which he had taken with tongs from the altar. ⁷ With it he touched my mouth and said, "See, this has touched your lips; your guilt is taken away and your sin atoned for." ⁸Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying, "Whom shall I send? And who will go for us?" And I said, "Here am I. Send me!"

GOSPEL LESSON: LUKE 5:1-11 (The Word of Jesus both creates the desire and ability to answer his call to discipleship). One day as Jesus was standing by the Lake of Gennesaret, the people were crowding around him and listening to the word of God.² He saw at the water's edge two boats, left there by the fishermen, who were washing their nets. 3 He got into one of the boats, the one belonging to Simon, and asked him to put out a little from shore. Then he sat down and taught the people from the boat. ⁴When he had finished speaking, he said to Simon, "Put out into deep water, and let down the nets for a catch." ⁵ Simon answered, "Master, we've worked hard all night and haven't caught anything. But because you say so, I will let down the nets." ⁶When they had done so, they caught such a large number of fish that their nets began to break.⁷So they signaled their partners in the other boat to come and help them, and they came and filled both boats so full that they began to sink. ⁸When Simon Peter saw this, he fell at Jesus' knees and said, "Go away from me, Lord; I am a sinful man!"⁹ For he and all his companions were astonished at the catch of fish they had taken, ¹⁰ and so were James and John, the sons of Zebedee, Simon's partners. Then Jesus said to Simon, "Don't be afraid; from now on you will fish for people." ¹¹So they pulled their boats up on shore, left everything and followed him.

P: This is the Gospel of our LORD.
